



Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Corridor

The East Main Street Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Corridor will run nearly 14 miles from Downtown Columbus through Reynoldsburg, helping to realize the LinkUS goals of addressing growth, bringing more transit options to the community and expanding opportunities for all. Destinations and neighborhoods along the corridor include:

- Downtown Columbus
- Olde Towne East/Near East Side
- Bexley
- Mideast/Eastmoor
- Whitehall
- Far East
- Reynoldsburg

The East Main BRT will increase access to key community resources including:

- 100,000 jobs
- 2 hospitals
- 24 grocery stores
- 17 K-12 schools
- 23 daycare facilities
- 15 pharmacies

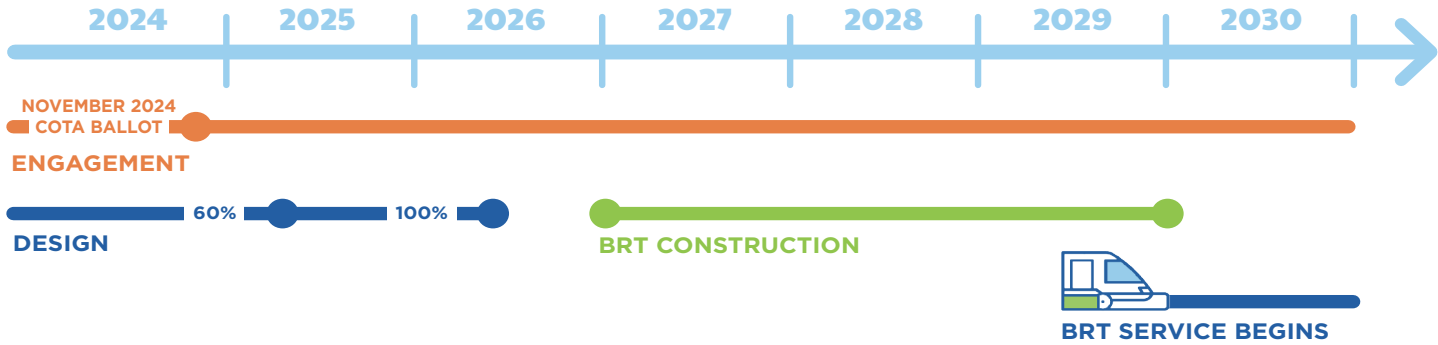
FAST & EFFICIENT BUS RAPID TRANSIT
