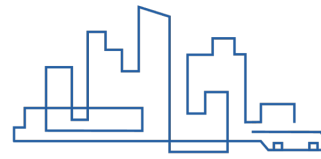


UPCOMING TSI PROJECTS



LINDEN GREEN LINE

Construct a 7-mile long linear park and trail along an abandoned rail corridor in the Linden / Northland communities, from 17th Avenue to Cooper Park. Connects with the Hudson Street Greenway and the Alum Creek Trail. **Tentative Construction Start: Q1 2027**

BIG WALNUT TRAIL

Construct a 2.5-mile greenway trail from Winchester Pike to Refugee Road.
Tentative Construction Start: Q2 2026

EASTMOOR GREEN LINE

Design and construct a 3-mile long linear park and trail along an abandoned rail corridor in the Eastmoor/Mideast neighborhoods, from East Broad Street to I-70.
Tentative Design Start: Q1 2026

FRANKLINTON LOOP

Design and construct a 2-mile bike / pedestrian route surrounding the Franklinton community. Includes on-street and off-street improvements, public engagement. **Tentative Start: Q2 2027**



UPCOMING CIP PROJECTS

BUSCH BALL DIAMONDS

Install Motz artificial turf ball fields and stormwater controls.

Tentative Construction Start: Q3 2025

SAMMONS BALL DIAMONDS

Install Motz artificial turf ball fields, site lighting, and stormwater controls.

Tentative Construction Start: Q3 2025

THREE CREEKS WETLAND RESTORATION

Restore and install wetlands at Three Creeks Park. **Tentative Construction Start: Q4 2025**

MOCK PARK CONSTRUCTION

Construction of a new indoor pickleball facility, stormwater controls, and miscellaneous site amenities. **Tentative Construction Start: Q4 2025**

HARD SURFACES PROGRAM 2025-2026

Paving sports courts, restoring pavements, and renovation of other concrete surfaces.

Tentative Construction Start: Q4 2025

NORTHEAST INDOOR AQUATIC CENTER

Events in early 2026 for potential subcontractors interested in the construction of this facility. Current project budget: \$65-75M. **Tentative Construction Start: Q1 2026**

HAYDEN PARK “NORTH STAR PARK” IMPROVEMENTS

Construction of new amenities at Hayden Park as well as a new site design that highlights the Underground Railroad’s history along the Alum Creek Trail.

Tentative Construction Start: Q1 2027
